


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# **Contents and Directions**

### Math

- 7 Graphing America Students will sort and count the cards with different objects. They will then fill in the bar graph with the appropriate number.
- 10 July Calendar Activity Students will answer the task card questions by using the provided calendar filled with information. They will then write their answers on their recording sheet.
- 15 Measure with the Stars Students will cut out a ruler of stars and use it to measure various objects on task cards. They will record their answers on their sheet.
- 19 Adding Change Students will add the change pictured on the cards and write their answers on the recording sheet.
- 26 Help George Washington Get Home Students will follow the path of odd numbers to get Washington back to his home.
- 27 Addition and Subtraction Story Problems Students will determine if the story problem on the task card is addition or subtraction and then write the correction equation on the recording sheet. There are two sets of cards. One is simple addition of single digits and the other set is double digit with no regrouping/borrowing. The teacher can choose the appropriate set for her class. OR Use the easier set at the beginning of the year and the more challenging set later in the year.

## Reading & Writing

- 32 Word Bank A printable sheet word bank with 42 relevant words for any America-related unit. Teacher can laminate and put in centers or hand out for students to use during the unit.
- 33 President True or False Students will cut out statements and determine if they are true or false. They will glue them in the correct section of their sheet.
- 35 Scrambled Sentences There are two options for this activity. In the first, students will unscramble the sentence on the six card set. They will write the correct sentence on the recording sheet. OR There is also a worksheet with the scrambled sentences (no cards) that can be unscrambled and written down.
- 42 America ABC Order Students will put four words on each task card in ABC order and write on recording sheet.
- 44 President Versus King Venn Diagram Students will brainstorm the differences and similarities between a king and president.

- 45 George Washington Versus Abraham Lincoln Venn Diagram Students will brainstorm the differences and similarities between the two presidents.
- 46 If I Were President Students will write a brief statement and illustrate four things they would do if they were president.
- 47 My American Favorites Mini Book Students will fill in blank of up to 12 different favorites and illustrate each half page. The teacher may choose as many different topics/ pages as she would like.
- 60 America Cross Out Students will cross out the word in each row that doesn't belong with the rest. They will then write a few sentences at the bottom using some of the words listed above.
- 61 My July 4th History Book Mini Book Students will learn fascinating facts about July 4th and illustrate each page.
- 68 How To Become President Students will list five steps to becoming president.
- 69 Dear Mr. President Students will write a letter to the president.
- 71 Four Great Things about America Students will write about four things they think are great about America.
- 72 My Favorite Place in America Students will write about their favorite place in America and illustrate it as though it is a newspaper article.
- 73 America List It Students will attempt to write one word about America for each letter of the alphabet.




